

From Fr. Michael

Today marks the beginning of the new Year of Grace (liturgical year) with the First Sunday of Advent. This season calls us to the virtues of patience and hope as we prepare for the coming of Christ, both at the end of time and in the remembrance of His birth at Christmas. I will be directing a Bible Study on Wednesdays, December 3, and December 10 in the St. Lawrence Parish Center at 6:00pm. I expect the session to go for just under an hour but will remain for questions afterward. The topic is *Advent with the Prophet Isaiah*. Please invite any friends or neighbors to join. It is helpful to bring your own Bible but not necessary.

On November 21, our chief shepherd, Bishop Persico, celebrated his 75th birthday. According to Church law, he submitted his letter to the Holy Father offering his resignation from the governance of the Diocese. Beginning today, he has asked all the parishes in the Diocese to pray for the new bishop. We will offer this prayer at each Sunday Mass until the new bishop is named. None of us knows how long this will take, but we should be prepared to wait several months. We are grateful for Bishop Persico's continued faithful shepherding of our Diocese and for his generous service to the people entrusted to his care.

Next week we celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Monday, December 8. This marks the patronal feast of the United States and remains a holy day of obligation (even on a Monday). Mass for the holy day is: Sunday, December 7 at 4:00pm and Monday, December 8 at 8:00am.

Deacon's Corner

Advent

As we start the Advent season, it is significant and exciting to know more about the history and what Advent means.

It is not certain when the first celebration of Advent was introduced into the Church. In the homilies from the sixth century from St. Maximus, Bishop of Turing, and St. Caserius, Bishop of Arles, we find discussions of preparation for the birth of Christ. The Gelasian Sacramentary notes five Sundays for the preparation season. The five Sundays were later reduced to four by Pope St. Gregory VII (1073-85).

Advent comes from the Latin phrase "ad-venire" or "to come to." It is the season encompassing the four Sundays and weekdays leading up to the celebration of Christmas.

Furthermore, Advent is a season of preparation, reminding us:

- <u>To Look Back</u> and reflect on the Lord's birth at Christmas
- To Look Ahead toward His second coming

The liturgical color for Advent is purple, like Lent, since both seasons are preparing us for a great feast day. In addition, Advent includes an element of penance in the sense of preparing, quieting, and disciplining our hearts for the full joy of Christmas.

This Advent season, let us remember to take some time to slow down and pray for God's peace. It also seems appropriate to contemplate that in the darkest winter season, that this is when God's "great and infinite light," Jesus Christ, came into the world.
