The Rosary of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary, is prayed every Saturday at St. Lawrence Church, beginning at 4:30, just before the 5:00 Mass.

~Mary invites all her children to pray her Rosary~

On Sundays during the Easter Season and most daily Masses, the first reading comes from the Acts of the Apostles. Since we are spending so much time reading from Acts, I thought it would be particularly relevant to look at this book of the Bible in greater detail.

The earliest tradition of the Church attributes this inspired book to Luke, the same writer as the Gospel of Luke. Luke most likely wrote his Gospel by the end of 62 A.D. and Acts of the Apostles between 62 and 64 A.D. Acts is Luke's presentation of biblical history, describing how the salvation promise to Israel in the Old Testament was accomplished by Jesus and has now under the Holy Spirit been extended to the Gentiles. It is a wonderful story that covers a large part of the origins of Christianity (Acts 11:26 – where it is recorded that the disciples of Jesus Christ were first called Christians) and the early Church.

Furthermore, Acts provides a broad survey of the Church's development from the Resurrection of Jesus to Paul's first Roman imprisonment, which is the point at which the book ends. The first half of Acts focuses on the discipleship of Peter and the second half focuses on the conversion and missionary journeys of Paul. The travels of Peter and Paul are, in reality, the travels of the Word of God as it spreads from Jerusalem to Rome, the capital of the civilized work of Luke's day.

According to an article from the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), there are five principal divisions of the Acts of the Apostles:

- 1. The Preparation for the Christian Mission (Acts 1:1 2:13)
- 2. The Mission in Jerusalem (Acts 2:14 8:3)
- 3. The Mission in Judea and Samaria (Acts 8:4 9:43)
- 4. The Inauguration of the Gentile Mission (Acts 10:1 15:35)
- 5. The Mission of Paul to the Ends of the Earth (Acts 15:36 28:31)

I hope this background on the Acts of the Apostles has provided some insight into the Mass readings. As we look at Acts, you should be able to enjoy the unfolding story of the early Church. The more we learn about and study Scripture, the more we know about our Catholic Faith.
