#### Being Thankful for God's Blessings

As we approach Thanksgiving, hopefully, you can pause and reflect on God's blessings from the past year. I am sure that for some years, it is more challenging than others to see any blessings. If it is challenging, maybe start with one or two things that we take for granted; a beautiful sunrise on a crisp Fall morning that starts by just lighting the tops of the trees, a walk around the block with the dog, or a cup of hot coffee or tea in the morning with a scone or warm cinnamon roll. In our neighborhood, I once saw a dad using a leaf blower on his front lawn, and his toddler son, who was about two years old, was jumping in the air with excitement. The fact that such a simple and ordinary thing as a leaf blower could create such exuberance and joy made me smile.

There are five types of Catholic prayer:

- Adoration we exalt the greatness of God, and we acknowledge our dependence on Him in all things.
- <u>Petition</u> we ask God for things we need primarily spiritual needs, but physical ones as well. We should have a
  willingness to accept God's Will.
- Intercession a prayer of petition, which leads us to pray as Jesus, did.
- Praise acknowledge God for what He is.
- Thanksgiving perhaps the most neglected type of prayer is a prayer of thanksgiving.

If prayer is a challenge, I try to start with one or two blessings I am thankful for. Also, it is a great time to remember the term "Eucharist" originates from the Greek word *eucharistia*, *meaning thanksgiving*.

Here is a simple prayer of thanks.

"Thank you, Father, for having created us and given us to each other in the human family. Thank you for being with us in all our joys and sorrows, for your comfort in our sadness, your companionship in our loneliness. Thank you for yesterday, today, tomorrow, and for the whole of our lives. Thank you for friends, for health, and for grace. May we live this and every day conscious of all that has been given to us."
